Keyword	Definition

Oceans: Pacific, Atlantic, Indian, Arctic, Southern.	A huge body of salt water that covers over half of the world's surface. There is one ocean that is divided into 5 main areas.	
Atlas	A book of maps or charts.	
Game Reserves	A large area of land set aside as a protected area for wild animals.	
Climate	The weather conditions in an area over a long period of time.	
The equator	An imaginary circle that runs around the middle of Earth.
