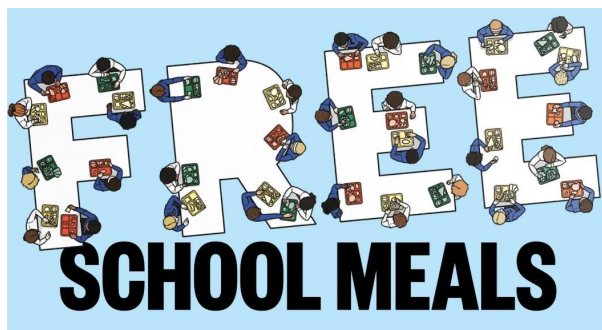
 Important: Any bottles containing alcohol must be brought directly to the school office by an adult and must not be sent in with children.

Changes to Free School Meals



We shared information on ClassDojo about upcoming changes to Free School Meals (FSM). These changes mean that all families who are currently receiving FSM will need to reapply. It also means that any families claiming Universal Credit may now be eligible for free school meals, which could result in a significant saving on dinner money. The system to recheck and apply is not yet available, but we will keep you updated as soon as further information is released.

Mobile Phones on Site

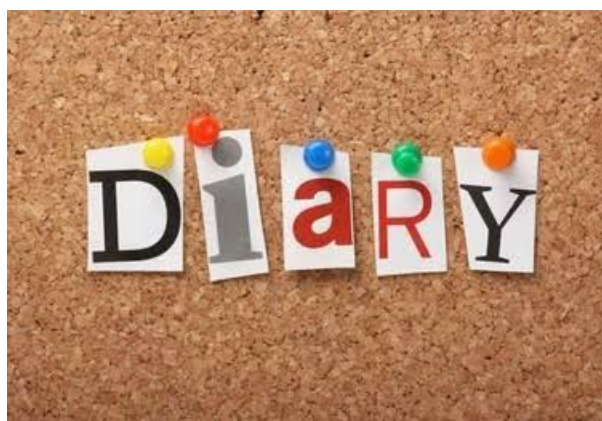
