



Art and Design through our projects in school

Reception – carried out and critiqued an observational drawings of a chosen shopfront from Worle High Street after visiting the street. Learnt about making different types of line. Experimented with making marks in clay then made a clay tablet of their shopfront.

Year 1 and 2 – learnt about Stephen Wiltshire’s architectural drawing style and used this learning to create their own architectural drawings of buildings in the local area using pencil and pens.

Year 3 and 4 – learnt about watercolour landscape paintings through studying the work of the Impressionist painter Monet. Went to Bristol Museum and Art Gallery to learn about landscape artists. Created their own river painting in an Impressionist style.

Year 5 and 6 – sketched and printed leaf images focusing on colour, shade, shape and making a clean print.

Studied Mexican Calavera’s. Designed their own Mexican Calavera, sculpted the head from clay, learning new sculpting techniques, painted their Calavera’s.

Studied the work of local Bristol graffiti artist Banksy. Then used his style as inspiration to design large scale murals for the bike shed area of the school. The classes worked together to produce collaborative murals.
